DMD LAMBDA ETA CHAPTER - COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Delta Mu Delta (DMD) International Honor Society in Business- Lambda Eta Chapter is honored to announce the Lambda Eta Chapter Community Service Award. The DMD Lambda Eta Chapter Community Service Award recognizes DMD members that have demonstrated not only a dedication to academic achievement but also a strong commitment to service and volunteerism by participating in community service work or volunteer activities while pursuing a degree at Northcentral University. The Award is given to students that have made significant contributions in their communities while maintaining high academic achievement.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the DMD Lambda Eta Chapter Community Service Award, scholarship applicants must have participated in community service work or volunteer activities while attending NCU. They must also meet the following criteria:

- Be a current DMD Member.
- Be enrolled at NCU in any business related degree program at time of application.

Currently serving DMD Officers at the time of application are ineligible to receive a scholarship.

All qualifying DMD members are encouraged to apply.

Guidelines for Application

In order to be considered for the award please submit:

- (1) A one-page, typed, double-spaced summary/ essay describing the community service or volunteer activity that you have participated including any role(s) you held and length of service. The primary focus of the essay should be on the contributions you made and any notable accomplishments. On a separate page please include
- (2) Reference(s) for the community service/ volunteer activity to include contact name, title/position (if any), phone number, and e-mail address. The reference(s) should be individual(s) that can attest to your involvement in community service or volunteer activities, your accomplishments, and contributions.

Note: Please ensure that correct contact information is given. References will be checked.



Award Details

Scholarship(s) in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded to deserving DMD members. The scholarship may be used towards graduation travel costs and lodging, tuition, or other education related fees. All applications for awards must be received on or before May 31, 2018. Applications will be reviewed June 4, 2018- June 18, 2018, and recipients will be notified via email by no later than June 30, 2018. Recipients of the award will be recognized during Lambda Eta Chapter pre-graduation events for the class graduating in 2018.

Review Criteria

A scholarship committee will review each application. Judges will consider several criteria when selecting award recipients, including:

- Role served in the community service or volunteer activity. Although not a primary
 determining factor in selecting an award recipient from those that meet the
 eligibility requirements for the community service scholarship, consideration will
 be given to leadership roles served in community service /volunteer activity while
 at NCU.
- The content of a one-page typed double-spaced summary/ essay submission.
- Validation of references

Application Instructions

To apply for the Community Service Award, DMD members must complete the attached application form and submit it, along with a one-page essay and references for consideration by **Monday**, **May 31**, **2018** to dmd@ncu.edu

Please include "2018 Community Service Award" in the Email Subject Line.

Incomplete scholarship applications will not be accepted or reviewed.
